Combine fellowship and education with pleasure by participating in one or two great golfing opportunities:

- 18 holes on an Arnold Palmer designed golf course, beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 12, 2006. Cost is **\$190** for green fee, cart, range balls, and entry fee. This assumes we are able to have a minimum of 24 players committed 30 days prior to the event.
- As an alternative, you may arrange your own tee times for 9 or 18 holes.

We have used a "captain's choice" format for the past two years, and this seems to provide fun for players of all handicaps. If you have your own 2-, 3-, or 4-person team, please send this information (names and handicaps) to Stan. He will assemble 4-person teams and assign overall handicaps, if needed.

Clubs can be rented for \$50 (plus tax).

Dress code is collar shirt and no denim; non-metal spike rules are enforced.

Food and drinks are available at the course.
